Review:

*Luckily we had a reservation....The restaurant was full and many people were lining up to get a seat! The menu has a **good range** of dishes on offer. We had an array of mixed **Antipasti** followed by **Pasta** and **Pizza**. The Antipasti ranged from thinly sliced **Bresaola** to **Saffron Arancini** and **grilled squid with garlic**. A great way to start and share a meal with **friends** and **family**. The Pasta was **hand made** and cooked perfectly. The **Gnocchi** with mixed wild mushrooms was excellent, slightly over salted. The Pizza was served **hot straight out of the pizza oven** with a perfect crisp. Remember Pizza should always be eaten **straight** from the oven. Once a Pizza ends up in a **"box"** as a take-away, will mark the end a good Pizza!*

*In general the food was good, tasty, **honest** and straight forward. Service was friendly and good. The restaurant has a few key features including the **open kitchen** in the back of the restaurant, **huge bar** in the middle and a **wine cellar area** to the left with a wide range of wines from the **region** and **overseas**. Overall a pleasant place to eat in St. Kilda.*
