Review

Criniti's in Parramatta is a very casual style of an Italian (South) Restaurant. Inside it is very dark (wood) and looks like a Sports Bar. Nevertheless their Menu (Food) is very extensive ranging from different Antipasti (Appetizers) to Wood - Fired Pizze, Pasta, Meat and Seafood dishes. The Antipasti we had (Fried Prawns and Beef Carpaccio) were OK but not well seasoned (very bland). The Main course (Gnocchi with Gorgonzola Cheese and Pancetta) was very good. The Gnocchi are homemade and melted in my mouth like little soft clouds. The Wood - Fired Pizza was as well very good with a nice crispy crust and good quality of toppings like Buffalo Mozzarella cheese, Proscuitto (Parma Ham), etc...

Overall it was an enjoyable meal in a very casual atmosphere. You can either sit inside or outside (during warmer months). In both locations the noise level is very high.
